April advice from the R.H.S includes:Mulching borders using organic matter
such as well rotted compost or wood
chippings to a depth of 5-10cm.
Lift and divide water lilies.
Plant your seed potatoes.
Sow vegetables such as: beetroot, carrots,
leeks and perpetual spinach into a
prepared seedbed.
